ATTORNEY MIKE NORRIS' REPORT: Absent

STEARNS & WHELER REPORT: Greg McCorkhill

- Water samples from the new well were taken and lab results and report will be ready by the next meeting.
- The water tests for MPA-Microscopic Particulate Analysis will not be needed after all. Both the County and State Department of Health agreed because of the depth of the well it would not be influenced by surface water.
- They are proceeding with the design of the treatment building. It was stated if we decide to put fluoride in system that it would require a separate room in the building.
- Board would like to have the building and the contents bid out separately so we can have the building up before winter. Greg said he would check with County DOH if they need to approve building design before it went out to bid. The board is anxious to have Contract 5 completed at end of this fiscal year.
- Discussion held on dirty water that we are still experiencing and having water tested in problem areas. The sequestering agent Calciquest is one of the best agents to use. They are getting the testing instruments calibrated and will do some testing once that is done.

MAYOR LAZARONY'S REPORT: Absent

CLERK ASTRY'S REPORT:

• Time Warner Cable tax needs to be abated.

- We need to renew our BAN for the upcoming year. Kelly Lathan came to our June workshop and discussed the BANS. She proposes to not add in new money because no decision has been made regarding North Shore Park and Dale Drive waterlines. The BAN will be renewed for \$3,170,000 because we have to make a \$65,000 principal payment. Last year's BAN was in the amount of \$3,235,000 and this is due on August 10, 2012 with interest payment of \$44,234.13. We can take a second BAN out when construction starts on Contract 5 and have the borrowing be below \$1M to avoid additional interest and also an official statement.
- After payment of our Abstract tonight we will have spent \$3,044,088.38 with \$29,896.50 still remaining on Contract 2.
- Contract 5 is estimated to be \$990,000, North Shore Park at \$240,000 and Dale Drive at \$960,000. No other side streets have estimates, nor any decision to replace lines.
- If we decide to do Dale Drive we would have to have a supplemental Bond Resolution or a separate Bond Resolution for the increase because it would put us over the original total project cost.
