GUESTS- Peter George from CBC reported as follows: Chautauqua County Health Network received a 5-year grant, ending this year. One major focus has been on Complete Streets and CCHN has worked closely with the Village and CBC.

To wrap up their 5-year effort, CCHN, in conjunction with CBC, wanted to complete an inventory of possible projects. They also wanted resident feedback on possible projects.

CBC agreed to gather that feedback from its membership.

Feedback received from CBC members identified 4 areas for potential improvement:

Control of vehicle speed

Added or improved sidewalks/crosswalks

Well timed maintenance of most active walking/cycling streets Park Ave. parking/ traffic control improvements

The most important ideas for Complete Streets improvements were: Lower speed limit on Rt 60 to 30 mph at Village border Increase speed enforcement / install speed warning signs Extend current Rt 60 sidewalk to ShurFine

Place distinctive highly visible crosswalks at key intersections

Turn Park Ave. into a one-way street with increased handicapped parking and expanded drop off zone at the beach

Pave/ line parking area across from the Village Hall for event parking

ABATE TIME WARNER REAL PROPERTY TAX

Trustee Astry moved, second by Trustee Flaherty to abate Time Warner Real Property tax of \$150.31 pursuant to 626 of NYS Real Property Tax Law. Special Franchise taxes may be partially or wholly reduced taxes by cable franchise payment. VOTE: 4 AYES, 0 NAYS.

DEPUTY CLERK MAZZONE REPORT: Absent

SUPT. OF PUBLIC WORKS SAM ALAIMO'S REPORT:

- Reported that the Cassadaga Wind Farm contractors have started getting loads of water and as of today there has been 25 loads. We are charging them \$ 100 per load and \$8.00 per 1000 gallons.
- Dennis Glasgot of 58B Frisbee Road has requested water service. He estimates cost of \$1425 that will be billed to him.
- He reported that CHIPS funding will be \$36,287.38 for Fiscal Year 2020-2021. He will be paving end of Commercial Street with Pave NY funds of \$ 5,418.90. We can also spend CHIPS funds on street related items.
- He has signed up Cassadaga to become a member of Sourcewell. They are a Cooperative Purchasing alliance with governments, education and nonprofit organizations. They hold hundreds of competitively solicited contracts ready for use. Choose from a wide array of products and services or work with their in-house specialist to find the solution that fits our needs. They award contracts at the manufacturing level, but they can be leveraged locally to support local dealers in our area. He checked on a new excavator and we can purchase through them and LandPro Equipment, Falconer, NY would be our supplier. We have budgeted for an excavator in our General and Water budget of \$ 9,000 each. He would like to use CHIPS funds and money in General budget for a new John Deere 35G Excavator at cost of \$39,599.79 and trailer for \$ 9,295 from water budget.
